This document describes the enhancements and modifications included in the latest release of Data360 Govern, and highlights any changes that may affect your current implementation.

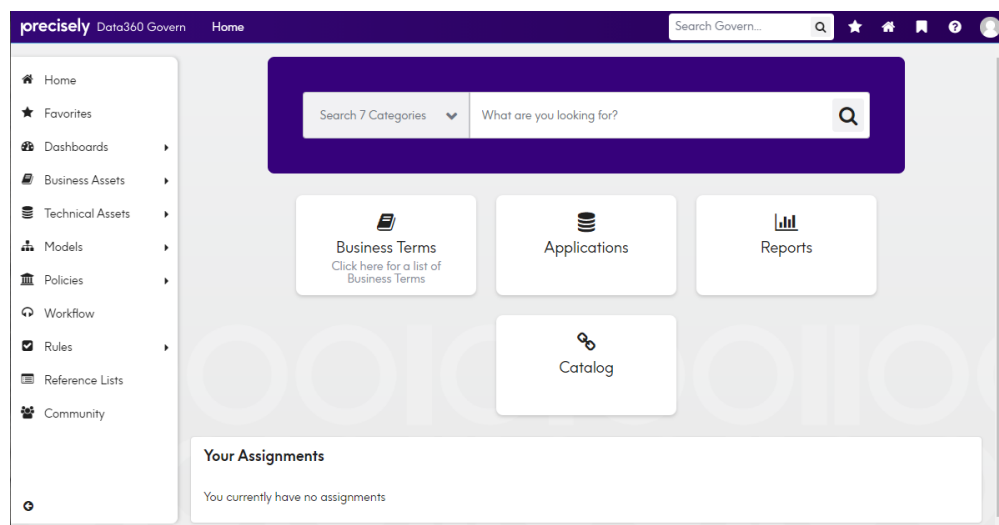

## 1.1 What's new

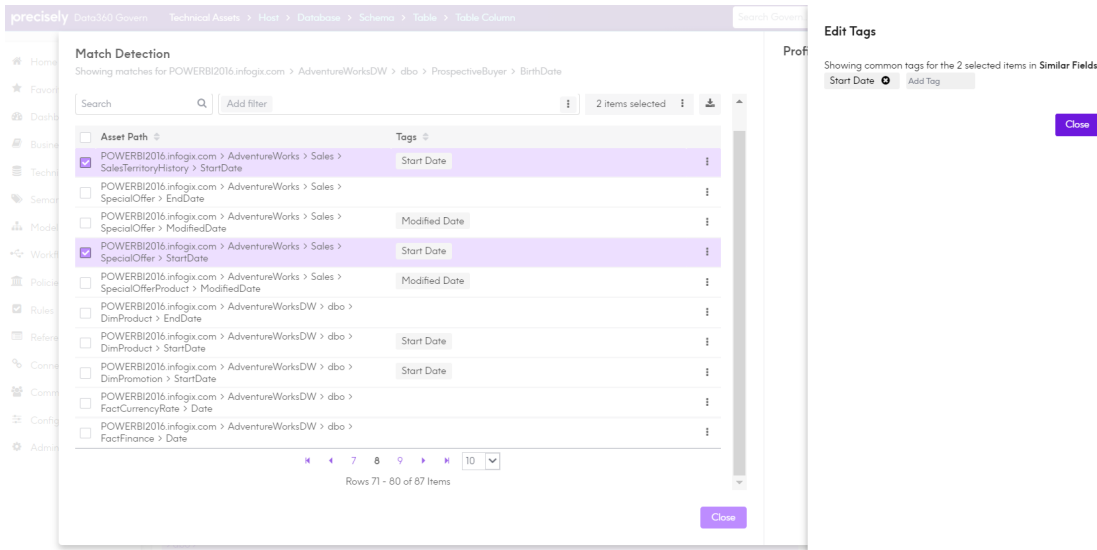
### Rebranding of Data360 Govern

The Data360 Govern UI and documentation styles and colors have been updated to match the Precisely brand.



## Add tags to the Match Detection dialog

You can now add and edit tags on the Match Detection dialog, or remove them, if required. Tags can be added to multiple asset paths, but not to both Duplicate Fields and Similar Fields at the same time.

## Side panel enhancements

### Information panel for Models

An Information side panel is now available on both the Models list grid and the Diagrams tab. For more information, see the "Browsing models" and "Information panel" topics in the help.

### Ownership tab added to Information panel

An ownership tab has been added to the Information side panel. This works in the same way as the ownership tab that was previously available on impact and lineage diagrams.

### Changes to the Profiling panel

The asset name and asset type have been added to the top of the Profiling panel.

## Changes to the Relation Lookup field type

The **Lookup Type** field has been removed from Relation Lookup field definition panel, while the **Relationship Type** dropdown list has been expanded to include the full asset type path.

## Changes to Responsibility Asset Assignments

The Asset Assignment grid on the Administration Responsibilities page now displays the asset type path, instead of the asset type.

## REST API enhancements

### Assets v2.0 API

The assets `POST api/v2/assets/{assetTypeUid}` and `POST api/v2/assets/batch/{assetTypeUid}` endpoints have been updated so you can specify your own UIDs for rule assets.

### Executions v2.0 API

- A new endpoint `GET api/v2/executions/bulkload` has been added, which returns all bulk load information.
- A new endpoint `GET api/v2/executions/bulkload/items/{load uid}`, has been added, which returns the bulk load items of a given load. To retrieve the load items, a UID for the given load must be provided.
- A new endpoint `GET api/v2/executions/bulkload/{load uid}` has been added, which returns the bulk load details for a given load.

## Other changes

- When adding a relationship, the asset path that's displayed on the grid in the Relationship tab of an asset, now wraps instead of eliding, making it clearly visible to read.
- When filtering on Complex fields is hidden, the Export to Excel option is displayed as a link, vertically inline with the field label.

- The ACTION\_DETAILS information in a workflow now displays in the same order as the information on a form.
- When defining a Relationship field on an asset type, the selection list will now show the asset type path, instead of just the asset type name of the related type.
- The shopping cart option has been removed from Administration > Settings, and will not be saved in the database.
- When the Action is set to Relation or Unrelation, the **Type** dropdown field of the Bulk Loader now shows the asset type path instead of the asset name.
- Sorting has been added to the Match Detection dialog.
- "Tag field not found" is now included in match detection exports, when appropriate.
- Lineage diagrams now show 2 loaders. One when retrieving data from APIs and another when the drawing of a diagram is in progress.

Fixed an issue that meant deleting a field type from an asset type, could result in an incorrect user appearing in the change log for affected assets.	GOV-15995

Fixed an issue in the Administration > Tags page, where deleting one or more tags would not refresh the grid after successfully deleting them.	GOV-16068
